

PUBLIC NOTICE

YOU HAVE A VOICE IN AIR POLLUTION CONTROL IN ARIZONA

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has reached a preliminary determination and is proposing to issue Air Quality Control Permit No's. 49159, 49393, 50083, 50423, 50424 and 50436 to CEMEX Construction Materials South, LLC for the following concrete batch plants. The plants are located at the following locations:

- 5231 E. Buffalo Soldier Trail in Sierra Vista, Cochise County for Permit No. 49159
- 11195 West County 21 ½ Street in San Luis, Yuma County for Permit No. 49393

The proposed permits are subject to the requirements of the Federal Clean Air Act, Arizona Revised Statute 49-426, and the Arizona Administrative Code, Title 18, Chapter 2, Article 3, 6, and 7. The proposed permits will limit emissions of the following types of air contaminants: particulate matter, particulate matter with an aerodynamic diameter less than 10 microns, oxides of nitrogen, carbon monoxide, sulfur dioxide, and volatile organic compounds.

This public notice provides information to help you participate in the decision-making process. You have an opportunity to submit written comments on any of these permits, and request that ADEQ hold a public hearing on any of these permits. The written comment shall state the name and mailing address of this person, shall be signed by the person, their agent or attorney and shall clearly set forth reasons why the permits should or should not be issued. Grounds for comment are limited to whether the permits meets the criteria for issuance spelled out in the state air pollution control laws or rules.

Persons wishing to submit written comments or request a Public Hearing can do so from the commencement of the public notice comment period beginning November 25, 2009, until December 28, 2009. ADEQ will consider all comments received in making a final decision on the proposed permits. Everyone commenting will receive notification of the final decision. People who file comments on the permit will have the right to appeal the final decision as an appealable agency action to the Office of Administrative Hearing (OAH) pursuant to §41.1092.03, and the appeal must be filed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of the final decision. The OAH may sustain, modify, or reverse the final decision.
