Notes: There is no fee for transfers, administrative amendments, or 317 changes of permits. The Department will charge \$500 for requests to add new equipment to general permit coverages.

Administrative and Inspection fees are due each year no later than February 1st of each year.

Pollutants for which annual emissions based fees are calculated are: Nitrogen oxides, volatile organic compounds, conventional air pollutants (except carbonmonoxide and ozone), any pollutant subject to Section 111 of the Act, and any federally listed hazardous air pollutant.
