

PUBLIC NOTICE

YOU HAVE A VOICE IN AIR POLLUTION CONTROL IN ARIZONA

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) proposes to issue the following: Air Quality Control Permit Renewals No. 62877 and No. 62878, and Air Quality Control Significant Revision Permit No. 63895 to Energy Fuels Resources (USA) Inc. for the operation of uranium mines at Canyon Mine (approximately 6 miles south of Tusayan, Coconino County), EZ Mine (approximately 37 miles south of Fredonia, Mohave County), and AZ1 Mine (approximately 35 miles south of Fredonia, Mohave County), respectively. These facilities are sources of particulate matter and products of combustion (carbon monoxide, nitrogen oxides, sulfur dioxide, and volatile organic compounds). The mailing address of the permittee is 225 Union Blvd., Suite 600, Lakewood, CO 80228. The facility is subject to the requirements of the Federal Clean Air Act, Code of Federal Regulations, Arizona Revised Statute 49-426, and the Arizona Administrative Code, Title 18, Chapter 2.

You have an opportunity to submit written comments on the permit renewals and revision and make oral comments at the public hearing. ADEQ will be holding three public hearings; Monday, August 29, 2016, at 6:00 pm at the Fredonia High School Gymnasium, 221 East Hortt, Fredonia, AZ 86022; Tuesday, August 30, 2016, from 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm at the Tuba City Chapter House, 220 South Main Street, Tuba City, AZ, 86045; and Tuesday, August 30, 2016, at Sinagua Middle School, Auditorium- Mini A, 3950 East Butler Avenue, Flagstaff, AZ 86004, at 6:00 p.m. The written comment shall include the name, mailing address, signature of commenter and/or their agent or attorney and shall clearly set forth reasons why the permit should or should not be issued. Grounds for comment are limited to whether the permits meet the criteria for issuance spelled out in the state air pollution control laws or rules.

The draft permits and related documentation are available for review Monday through Friday between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., at the [ADEQ Records Center](#), at 1110 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona. The documents are also available at the Town of Fredonia, Town Clerks' Office at 25 N Main in Fredonia, AZ 86022., the Mohave County Clerk's Office at 700 West Beale, Kingman, AZ 86401, the Coconino County Clerk's Office, 219 East Cherry, Flagstaff, AZ 86001, and at the Tuba City Library, 78 Main Street, Tuba City, AZ 86045. The public notice period is in effect from July 25, 2016 to August 30, 2016. Persons wishing to submit written comments can also do so at the public hearing. Comments must be received by August 30, 2016.

ADEQ will consider all comments received in making a final decision on the proposed permit revision. Everyone commenting will receive notification of the final decision. People who file comments on the permit revision will have the right to appeal the final decision as an appealable agency action to the Office of Administrative Hearing (OAH) pursuant to §41.1092.03, and the appeal must be filed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of the final decision. The OAH may sustain, modify, or reverse the final decision.
